## ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Rope Volunteers assist the OTE Global technical team on Friday, March 15 (VIP/Media Day), and Saturday, March 16 (Event Day). Training is on Friday, March 15, and **rope volunteers have the opportunity to rappel the building on Friday** (schedule permitting).

Individuals with ropes experience, such as climbers, cavers, firefighters and SWAT, are preferred. However, anyone with an enthusiastic and safety conscious mindset can become a rope volunteer. Over The Edge technical staff provides all training, direct supervision, and management of Rope Volunteers.

### Rope Volunteer Expectations and Positions

1. Watch a 1 hour online video before the event
2. Attend a 3-hour training session on Friday, March 15 (Media/VIP Day)
3. Volunteer all day on Saturday, March 16 (Event Day)



**Roof Volunteers** support the Site Safety Supervisor at main rappel area, help to load participants and coach them over the edge. **Training Volunteers** support the Training Manager in training all participants before they go over the edge. **Staging Volunteers** support the Staging Manager and help get participants into gear and ready to go on the roof. **Landing Zone Volunteers** belay ropes and assist participants when they finish their rappel.
